Green Thumb Planter Box: Connect children to nature through hands-on exploration. *Children are provided varied opportunities and materials to learn key content and principles of science such as the difference between living and non-living things and life cycles of various organisms.*

Learning Puddle: Provides multisensory opportunities to explore, discover and experiment. *Children are provided varied opportunities and materials that encourage them to use the five senses to observe, explore, and experiment with scientific phenomena.*

Outdoor classroom: Bring learning outdoors by combining learning panels and the PlayPod Reading Circle. *Teaching staff join children in learning centers to extend and deepen children's learning. Gallery Panel: Use this panel to display children's artwork, tie-in curriculum and provide extended learning outdoors. *Children have opportunities to respond to the art of other children and adults.*

Find 'n Seek: This interactive game promotes cooperation, language development and shape recognition as children create their own games. *Children have varied opportunities and are provided equipment to engage in large motor experiences that: help them learn physical games with rules and structure.*
