

1 Unpack & Verify Contents

After un-boxing your TechDisc Pro™ take a minute to verify the contents:



i IMPORTANT: Please keep the packaging for your Commercial Series Duplicator. If you ever need to send the unit in for repair, the unit must be shipped in its original packaging.

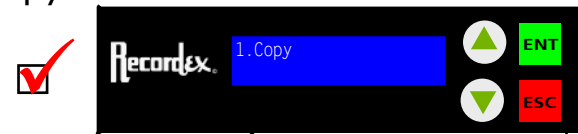
Also, if your machine was damaged during shipment you should immediately place a damage claim with the carrier.

3 Power on Duplicator

After plugging in the duplicator switch on the ON/OFF rocker switch located on the back of the system.



After running a short self-test routine (approximately 20 seconds) the duplicator will be ready to make a copy.

2 Duplicator Set Up

Connect the power cable to your duplicator and plug the cable into a grounded power outlet.

Optimum environment:

- ✓ Stable and level surface
- ✓ Well ventilated
- ✓ Low dust and no smoke
- ✓ Stable temperature and humidity

i Recordex recommends that you always use a surge protector or an uninterruptible power supply (UPS) to protect your duplicator from harmful power surges.

i Double check to make sure that your duplicator is set to operate at the correct voltage. The factory default is 115V. If you are operating in a region that requires 230V then you should change the 115/230V switch using a small flat head screwdriver.



4 Load Source & Copy Media

Insert the disc you want to copy into the top disc drive. Next insert blank media into the remainder of the target drives. NOTE: It is not necessary put media in all the drives.



5 Copy Discs

Simply press the **ENT** button to make perfect duplicates of your master disc.
