DESCANT is a multi-format music notebook that combines college ruled notebook paper with the traditional music manuscript. Simple yet effective, this concept was developed by a Manhattan School of Music undergraduate to help efficiently orchestrate and organize his theory notes and document new ideas for compositions in development.

This multi-format notebook helps streamline notes, organize sketches, coordinate arrangements and methodically construct scores. The notebook is a fantastic teaching and learning tool for beginners as well as an efficient composing tool for professional musicians and artists.
